### **Matters Arising From PC Meeting 10 January 2017**

Chris Burt reported that the Council have obtained permission to have a dog bin supplied by PBC to be fixed to the wooden fence by the stile in Jinny Lane. We expect this to arrive at any time but will keep chasing until it does. Dog Fouling notices have been put onto this same fence and others will be put up around the Parish.

### **Reports From Councillors**

Chris Burt reported that he has donated a water butt and installed it outside the toilets in Newchurch so that the water collected can be used for watering.

GBPC has taken delivery of the new noticeboard and Carl Ryder has kindly offered to put it in place in Newchurch village centre .

Carl Ryder reported that the Lengthsman has thinned out more trees in Sparable Wood and cut back the overgrown tree in front of the toilets in Newchurch. He has had complaints from residents about parking at the school and he has suggested that he could approach PC Mark Dibb for advice.

### **Agenda Items**

GBPC is pleased to announce that Bob Donovan has been co opted as a Parish Councillor with immediate effect.

The council is committed to establishing contact with the residents of Sabden Fold who are not directly represented on the council . An important step is to put up a noticeboard to advertise the council business and we will attend to this in the near future.

The standing Orders were reviewed and the Chairman will make further enquiries about electronic payments.

It is the Council's intention to repair the tourist map currently shown in Newchurch village centre. We are awaiting an estimate to have it reprinted and reframed.

The Annual Parish Meeting will be held in May and will be on a date to be arranged.
