

The following is a summary of the main points covered at the Parish Council meeting on Tuesday 8 January 2019.

PC Dibb attended the meeting to introduce himself to new councillors and to discuss the current situation relating to policing in the area.

Reports from Councillors.

Following a request from residents of Sabden Fold, it was decided to purchase an extra grit bin to be used on Lower Houses Hill on Haddings Lane.

It was confirmed that the Parish Council would assist clearing in the event of heavy snow and if the response from LCC was not sufficient.

Other Agenda Items.

The PC agreed to submit a bid for £2000 to Barrowford and Western Parishes Committee to purchase a CCTV system.

It was decided by a majority decision for Goldshaw Booth Parish Council to object to the application 18/0818/FUL at Douglas Hall Kennells on the grounds of visual impact in an AONB, noise, cross contamination and animal welfare issues.

Spenbrook Mill.

Laurence Daw of Cheshire Estates will attend the next PC meeting to discuss the development at Spenbrook Mill. All residents are invited to attend and will be able to ask questions about any concerns they have.

Budget 2019/2020

The budget was thoroughly discussed and all items of expenditure were justified. The precept was agreed and set at £6700.
