Councillor J Parsons provided a sign for the toilets. Goldshaw Booth Parish Council were awarded £1500 for the Capital Programme at the meeting of Barrowford and Western Parishes Committee held 3 July 2014. The Friends of Fields in Trust Yearly Membership Fee £50.
