

**The following is a summary of the main points that were discussed at the
Parish Council meeting on 14th November 2017.**

Matters Arising from Previous Meeting

The new notice board has been installed in Spen Brook by Councillors Burt and Stuttard. This is a welcome addition to the village. The old one will eventually be removed.

It was reported that some residents are removing official parish notices to make room for adverts on the board. The parish council welcomes appropriate advertising on the board, for community events etc, but this should not be at the expense of official parish notices.

Councillor Reports

Carl Ryder reported that the bonfire was a success and well attended.

Residents have requested to plant their own trees with remembrance plaques in Sparable Wood. The Parish Council has no objection. Work will be coordinated with the future replanting project.

A resident has kindly offered to plant the barrier baskets in the centre of Newchurch free of charge. The Parish Council is grateful for the offer.
