

**The following is a summary of the main points discussed at the Parish Council meeting on 9<sup>th</sup> April 2019**

Work on the 4 benches within the church yard has now been completed.

A planning application by Cheshire Estates for an additional detached property on the mill site was discussed at length. The only concerns raised were with regard to the negative effect this may have on existing infrastructure such as roads and utilities etc, concerns that have been raised by members of the public before based on the original number of properties proposed.

A number of quotes have been received for CCTV equipment for the villages and a decision will be made next month.

An application has been made to enter the annual Best Kept Village competition. Judging will take place over the summer and a Tidy Up Day has been arranged for Saturday 18th May at 10:30, meeting at the school. Refreshments will be provided for residents who wish to volunteer.

The Annual Parish Meeting, which residents are encouraged to attend will take place on Tuesday 14<sup>th</sup> May 2019 at 8pm.
