

The following is a summary of the main points discussed at the Parish Council meeting held on the 11th June 2019.

First of all we would like to thank all the volunteers that turned out on Saturday 18th May for the Tidy Up Day. We are sure the work will not go unnoticed when judging for the Best Kept Village Competition takes place. Judging will take place between the 8th June and 21st July, with the second round taking place between 9th and 21st August and the final judging days will be on the 29th and 30th August 2019.

Pendle Borough Council will carry out their annual inspection of the play areas in July 2019.

This month two new planters have been installed at Sabden Fold and the Parish Council has requested replacement grit bins for Newchurch. This will further enhance the area.

The plans to install CCTV in the Parish are still ongoing.

Bob Donovan and his wife have kindly donated their time and skills to undertake works on the inside of the toilet block. All the toilets are now operational in time for the Pendle Pub Walk taking place on Saturday 15th June 2019. It is intended that the toilets will be fully open at weekends for a trial period.
